Đại học Quốc gia Thành phố Hồ Chí Minh (ĐHQG-HCM) nhận được thông tin từ Mạng lưới các trường Đại học Đông Nam Á (AUN) về việc mời tham dự Diễn đàn Giáo dục và Cuộc thi Nhà hùng biện Trẻ lần thứ 19 của AUN và lần thứ 8 của ASEAN+3 (The 19th AUN and 8th ASEAN+3 Educational Forum and Young Speakers' Contest) tại Thái Lan.

1. Thông tin về Diễn đàn và Cuộc thi:

Diễn đàn Giáo dục là một trong các hoạt động chủ điểm dành cho thanh niên của AUN. Chương trình chính thức bắt đầu từ năm 1998 nhằm xây dựng nhận thức chuyên sâu về ASEAN cho các nhà lãnh đạo tương lai trong khu vực. Đồng thời, Diễn đàn này còn là nền tảng cho thanh niên các nước ASEAN+3 bày tỏ quan điểm về các vấn đề trong khu vực cũng như về tương lai khu vực thông qua các đề xuất xây dựng chính sách.

Cuộc thi Nhà hùng biện Trẻ là một hoạt động của Diễn đàn Giáo dục, nhằm mục đích thúc đẩy hợp tác giữa các nhà lãnh đạo trẻ của các nước ASEAN+3, nâng cao nhận thức và hiểu biết của giới trẻ về các cơ chế hợp tác và tương lai của khu vực.

Diễn đàn và Cuộc thi năm nay có chủ đề: Social Sustainability in ASEAN+3: The Challenges of Inclusive Growth.

2. Số lượng: ĐHQG-HCM sẽ đề cử 02 sinh viên (gồm 01 sinh viên tham dự Diễn đàn Giáo dục và 01 sinh viên tham dự Cuộc thi Nhà hùng biện Trẻ) và 01 giảng viên tham dự.

3. Hỗ trợ tài chính:

- Ban tổ chức sẽ đài thọ chi phí ăn ở và phương tiện di chuyển nội địa trong các sự kiện trên cho sinh viên và giảng viên tham dự;
- Đơn vị cử đi sẽ chi trả các chi phí còn lại cho giảng viên tham dự theo qui định hiện hành;
- Sinh viên tự chi trả các chi phí còn lại.

4. Thời gian: ngày 10-14 tháng 6 năm 2019.



5. Điều kiện dự tuyển:

5.1. Điều kiện dự tuyển dành cho sinh viên:

- Là sinh viên ĐHQG-HCM, ưu tiên cho sinh viên đang học năm 2, năm 3;
- Có kiến thức về chủ đề của sự kiện, về Đông Nam Á và Đông Á;
- Có tinh thần làm việc nhóm, khả năng giao tiếp tốt;
- Có sức khỏe tốt, có khả năng thích nghi với hoàn cảnh;
- Khả năng tiếng Anh lưu loát;
- Cam kết tham dự suốt thời gian sự kiện.

5.2. Điều kiện dành cho giảng viên:

- Là giảng viên thuộc các đơn vị thành viên và trực thuộc ĐHQG-HCM;
- Có kiến thức sâu về ASEAN và Đông Á;
- Có khả năng giao tiếp tốt;
- Có sức khỏe tốt, có khả năng thích nghi với hoàn cảnh;
- Khả năng tiếng Anh lưu loát;
- Cam kết tham dự suốt thời gian sự kiện.

6. Hồ sơ dự tuyển:

- Đơn đăng ký đã hoàn tất mục thông tin cá nhân của sinh viên và giảng viên;
- Sinh viên tham dự Diễn đàn Giáo dục nộp 01 bài tiểu luận bằng tiếng Anh (Policy Paper có độ dài 1 trang) trình bày về chính sách và quan điểm của quốc gia về chủ đề sự kiện;
- Sinh viên tham dự Cuộc thi Nhà hùng biện Trẻ nộp 01 bài tiểu luận bằng tiếng Anh dài không quá 1.500 từ về chủ đề sự kiện.

7. Quy trình nộp hồ sơ:

- Các đơn vị phổ biến thông tin và tiến hành tiếp nhận, chọn lọc hồ sơ để đề cử sinh viên và giảng viên phù hợp tham dự sự kiện;
- ĐHQG-HCM thực hiện công tác xét tuyển và đề cử sinh viên và giảng viên đến Ban tổ chức sự kiện trước ngày 30/4/2019; đồng thời thông báo kết quả xét tuyển đến sinh viên, giảng viên và hướng dẫn hoàn tất thủ đăng ký tham dự chương trình;
- Sinh viên chỉnh sửa bài tiểu luận theo sự hướng dẫn của giảng viên và gửi lại cho Ban tổ chức sự kiện trước ngày 15/5/2019;
- Sinh viên và giảng viên gửi thông tin chuyển bay đến Ban tổ chức sự kiện trước ngày 25/5/2019.

Concept Note

Social Sustainability in ASEAN+3: The Challenges of Inclusive Growth

The importance of inclusive growth has become a significant part of emerging consensus on recent development discourse, as many countries have experienced economic growth process without significant improvement in income equality, poverty alleviation, and other socio-economic shortcomings.

Economic development is necessary for the improvement of quality of people's life in every country. However, for economic development to be more equitable and sustainable, the process should be accompanied by the development of social sustainability.

There is an emerging consensus that policy makers need to be more committed in addressing problems related to social sustainability. Economic growth does not automatically translate into improved social sustainability. Good and sound policy, cooperation of non-government sectors, and community and people engagement are also needed.

ASEAN+3 countries are at different stages of development with varying development needs and priorities. The different stages of development among ASEAN+3 countries create different challenges related to the development of social sustainability and the resources available to address the issue.

For example, in East Asia, Japan and South Korea have clearly achieved very impressive economic development so that they have now reached the high-income economy and developed society status. But with emerging problems like ageing population, they too need to make their future economic growth more inclusive. For some low-income ASEAN countries, they are still at the stage of struggling with their primary objective of maximizing economic growth in order to provide the material basis for poverty reduction. Other middle-income ASEAN countries have achieved remarkable economic growth; but they still have to fulfill their other development needs, including reducing their high income inequalities.

Despite the differing conditions in each ASEAN+3 country, it was observed that the policies and measures to address social sustainability in the context of inclusive growth ought to involve a whole-of-a-government or a comprehensive approach that cuts across the economic, social and political dimensions. The commitment is on each ASEAN+3 country to find the right mix of these dimensions in line with its local conditions before they could embark on the policy enhancement to maintaining and strengthening social sustainability as new ground of regional cooperation.

The main output of the Forum is “Youth Joint Statement”. At the end of the forum, students will come up with an ASEAN+3 Youth Joint Statement. The statement will then be submitted to the ASEAN Senior Officials Meeting on Youth (SOMY) through the ASEAN Secretariat for reference and further action. The policy paper and country position paper will be submitted together with the Youth Joint Statement to SOMY.

The forum will give recognition to the followings:

- Most Outstanding Working Group (Group)
- Most Outstanding Delegate (Individual)

IMPORTANT: The details of the parliamentary procedures, writing and format for the policy paper, dos and don'ts, awarding and judging system, and joint statement writing are all written on the Full Educational Forum Guideline.

Deadline and Submission Process:

All assignments will be submitted to AUN Secretariat **within 15 May 2019.**

AUN Secretariat will link the delegates by country and inform the further details with the participants after registration process.

Use of electronic devices

The delegates are encouraged to bring their laptops, ipads, and other electronic devices that will be used for research and produce outputs at the Forum such as Powerpoint Presentation and Drafting of Joint Statement.

Guideline for the Young Speakers' Contest 2019

Young Speakers' Contest Topic: *Social Sustainability in ASEAN+3: The Challenges of Inclusive Growth*

Participating universities are requested to nominate one (1) student representative.

Prior to the event, participating students are requested to submit the following to the AUN Secretariat:

- An individual essay reflecting the topic of not more than 1,500 words. This will be compiled and will be distributed to everyone in e-version after the end of the contest.

Deadline and Submission: Prepared essays will be submitted to the AUN Secretariat within 15 May 2019.

The Young Speakers' Contest is composed of two rounds:

- **The First Round**
Each student will be given 5-7 minutes (maximum of 7 minutes) to deliver prepared speech.
- **The Final Round** (6 Finalists)
Each finalist will be given 1 hour to prepare for a 5 minutes speech on new topic.
After the 5 minutes speech, followed by the follow up question (1 question for all) which he/she needs to respond to for another 2 minutes.

The Young Speakers' Contest (the First Round, and the Final Round) will open to public, with an aim to raise the profile of ASEAN and Plus Three countries' cooperation among the region's next generation of leaders and to deepen the awareness and understanding young people have on their region's cooperation mechanisms and their future viability.

The Contest will give the following awards:

- Winner
- 1st Runner Up
- 2nd Runner Up
- Runners Up

IMPORTANT: The detailed contest and judging procedures are written on the Full Operational Guideline.

Roles of the Faculty Members

1. **Accompany and mentor the students throughout the programme.**
2. **At Educational Forum**, the faculty members are requested to score the Most Outstanding Working Group Award.
3. **At Young Speakers' Contest**, the faculty members are requested to serve as Judges for the 1st round in order to select the 6 finalists for the final round.

Note: The Criteria for Judging and the Point System are both written on the attached Guideline

SUMMARY OF OPERATIONAL GUIDELINE

Guideline for the Educational Forum 2019

Educational Forum Topic: *Social Sustainability in ASEAN+3: The Challenges of Inclusive Growth*

Participating universities are requested to nominate one (1) student representative.

Prior to the Forum, participating students are requested to submit the following to the AUN Secretariat:

- 1 page Policy Paper (Individual Work) within 15 May 2019.
- Prepare 10 minutes presentation of Country Position based on individual policy papers (Group Work by Country).

What is a Policy Paper?

Policy paper is a three paragraphs essay outlining the country's policies and viewpoints about the given topic. It will serve as a roadmap on how the student representatives properly represent their respective country based on their country's actual policies and position.

What is a Presentation of Country Position?

The Country Position presentation is the country position. It will be done as a group work and the content is based on individual policy paper submitted earlier. **One country will prepare ONE presentation.** (i.e.: Burapha University, Chiang Mai University, Chulalongkorn University, Mahidol University, and Prince of Songkla University have to work together to present only 1 country position for Thailand).

Upon Arrival Date, participants will be given time to do final preparation to present their Country Position during Session I (Day 1)

After the registration deadline, AUN Secretariat will link the representatives of the participating universities per country. For the case of countries who only have one member university in the network (i.e. Universiti Brunei Darussalam and National University of Laos), the delegate has to write his/her country position paper by him/herself.

For the actual forum, the students will be asked to present a 10 minute Country Position that they have prepared previously as a team (one presentation per one country).

All delegates are encouraged to discuss, inquire, and comment by observing the rule of a *Forum Procedure* (Refer to Full Operational Guideline).

The main output of the Forum is “Youth Joint Statement”. At the end of the forum, students will come up with an ASEAN+3 Youth Joint Statement. The statement will then be submitted to the ASEAN Senior Officials Meeting on Youth (SOMY) through the ASEAN Secretariat for reference and further action. The policy paper and country position paper will be submitted together with the Youth Joint Statement to SOMY.

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


